

large Rainbow Trout, Dolly Varden, Kokanee and Lake Trout, all of which can be caught on flies, spinners or trolling gear all season long. And, with over 30 small lakes within an hours drive, we are a great location for the

Guided Fishing Packages... Let us take you down a Heritage River by drift boat so you can concentrate on your dry fly presentation to the wild resident 'bows that can average 2-3 pounds and can exceed 10 pounds! Travel by jet boat to a Sockeye stream in the Cariboo

Mountains Park, where you can spot and stalk the big 'bows and Pollies that follow the Sockeye out of the lake and into the river to forage on egg patterns. Wet- or dry-fly fish one of our uncrowded small lakes, and fish the big lake seeking a large 10+ pound 'bow. These may be the best fishing experiences anywhere to be found.
